Policy Statement

At FHBB, we strive to create a safe and organized environment for our volunteers to carry out their duties effectively. While FHBB endeavors to provide a safe environment for volunteers and their belongings, we cannot accept liability for any lost, stolen, or damaged personal items. Volunteers are encouraged to exercise caution and discretion when bringing valuables onto the premises. To ensure the security of personal belongings and maintain a clutter-free workspace, we have established the following guidelines for managing personal items.

Designated Storage Spaces

Volunteers are encouraged to utilize designated lockers, cabinets, and other surfaces provided by FHBB for storing personal belongings during their shifts.

Use of Locks

Volunteers may bring their own locks to secure their belongings in designated storage areas if desired. It is the responsibility of the volunteer to ensure that their locker or storage space is securely locked.

End-of-Shift Responsibility

Volunteers must remember to remove their personal belongings, including any locks used, at the end of their shift. FHBB is not responsible for any items left behind after the volunteer shift concludes.
